

**Ilderton Skating Club**  
**Synchronized Skating Program**  
**Fee/Payment Policy**

Due to difficulties in collecting payments for the synchronized skating program, the Ilderton Skating Club has passed the following policies concerning payment of skater fees. Please read carefully.

1.- Synchronized skating registration fees, including post-dated cheques, are due on or before the first regularly scheduled practice and/or synchro registration nights with the Ilderton Skating Club for the team that the skater is registered for. Any skater who has not submitted all of their registration cheques will not be allowed on the ice for synchro practice until payment has been received.

2.- Any skater who withdraws from an ISC synchronized skating team before December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year will be responsible for 50% of their fees, PLUS the full administration fee, Skate Canada fee, WOS fee (if applicable), as well as 50% of their fundraising requirement. Any skater who withdraws from a synchronized skating team on or after January 1<sup>st</sup> of the year will be responsible for full payment of their fees, PLUS the administration fee, Skate Canada fee, WOS fee (if applicable), as well as 100% of their fundraising requirement for that team.

3.- Any skater who joins a team after December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year, will be responsible for 50% of the registration fees, PLUS the administration fee, Skate Canada fee, WOS fee (if applicable), as well as 50% of their fundraising requirement.

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**Financial Policy**

When registering for a skating program with the Ilderton Skating Club, including synchronized skating, payments (cheques/post-dated cheques), must be submitted before the skater enters the ice. Any deviation from the standard payment plan must be pre-approved by the treasurer, in writing.

**Returned Payments**

The RPA will notify the parent/skater by e-mail, copying the treasurer and/or synchro treasurer if the payment relates to the synchro program, indicating a replacement payment, plus a \$25.00 charge, due immediately. After two weeks, if payment has not been received the treasurer will contact the parent. If the treasurer cannot obtain payment the skater will be barred from the ice and collection efforts by a third party will be initiated. In any membership year a

second payment returned by the bank will incur a \$50.00 charge and all future payments must be made by cash, money order or certified cheque within the original payment plan schedule.
